


Our Lady FFP Newsletter

1. Outreach Opportunity:

• My name is Shannon Cooch and recently my 13-year-old son has been attending baseball practice at St. Ed's as a member of the Release 13 U team. My son and the other boys that carpool mentioned they always see someone asking for food or money on the exit ramp off the highway on their way to and from practice. Upon leaving town we met a man outside the Circle K that may have been struggling with meeting basic needs as well. We had a charming conversation about baseball and I could tell that he appreciated seeing the boys in their practice gear. All of this is coinciding with my son's recent invitation to join Beta Club, an honor society of sorts for middle schoolers. We

realized that during the pandemic he has not been presented with many service opportunities. Thus, we began to brainstorm that maybe he could dedicate a little time and money to the faces he sees in and out of Lakewood on his weekend trips to baseball. After doing some quick research on an outreach for the homeless in Lakewood, I found that St. Ed's already has a program set up. Basically, my son and I are wondering if FFP Families would like to help donate needed items.

- 10. gift cards to Giant Eagle for the service volunteers to use throughout the year to round out what they can take on the Thursday nights
